These are people who would be eligible for nursing homes, however they do not house people. ○ Full clinic, gym, home health, hospice, transportation, meals, etc. ○ PACE has been around for nearly 40 years. In 2016, WelbeHealth got involved. ○ Both the insurer and the service provider ○ Capacity for the Stockton building is 600 roughly 300 members at a time. 	Jim Shields
