Concerns were expressed that the seniors get lost in homeless, they need to carve out funding directed at Older Adults Housing.</p> <p>Each goal has a target, strategies and current initiatives that are in place or can be in place to help achieve the strategies. In the next few months, discussions on each goal will be added to the agenda to help explain each goal and process to reach implementation.
